



## Girls Scouts-Western Oklahoma, Inc. Girl Scout Bronze Award

*New Guidelines*

*If you would like to participate in the GS-WESTOK Award Ceremony for the current year, you must submit your completed Bronze Award Final Project to the Program Dept by March 1.*

- Age Requirements for the Bronze Award:
  - You must be in 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> grade and a registered Junior Girl Scout to complete your Bronze Award.
  - You may begin your project during the summer prior to your 4<sup>th</sup> grade school year.
- Money Earning Activities for the Bronze Award:
  - You must have **prior** approval from the Service Unit Director for *any* money earning activities (money earning or acceptance of any gifts).
  - If you are working for another organization, you **may not** earn money or seek monetary contributions for that organization.
    - If you are working for another organization, you will need to have a pre- and post-letter from that organization. *Ask your Adult Advisor for details regarding the letter.*
  - Your Bronze Award Project should not make any profit. The monies that you collect should be for out-of-pocket expenses.
- When filling out your application and report form please type or print in black ink.

### **Here are the steps you will take to earn your Girl Scout Bronze Award:**

1. Complete one Junior Journey
2. Build Girl Scout Junior Team
3. Explore your community
4. Choose your project
5. Make a plan
6. Put your plan into motion
7. Spread the word

*The suggested minimum time for earning your Girl Scout Bronze Award is 20 hours. These suggested hours are a “guide” not a “requirement”*

### **For FINAL approval of your Bronze Award Project:**

- Make 2 copies of this entire package: the original is submitted to GSWEST c/o Programs Department, a copy for your Advisor, and keep a copy for yourself.
- Make sure that you include:
  - Copies of flyers, pictures or emails concerning your project.
  - Budget sheet
- Remember - if you have any questions, need help or advice, please contact your Adult Advisor. If she/he is unavailable, then contact the Council Program department. We are here to assist you by answering your questions or giving guidance in the completion of your Bronze Award Project.
