Trails & Tales

A Special Adventure for age levels Junior and up!!!

The *Trails & Tales* program will help you discover Oklahoma heritage throughout Western OK

Use the list of Northern counties on the other side of this sheet to help you plan your adventure within one of the three geographical designations within the GS-Western OK Council: *Eastern, Central or Western*. The adventure must include a visit to one location in each of the following categories: Ghost Town, Natural or Scenic Site, Museum, Commercial or Business Site, and a Historic Site. *Trails & Tales* is designed for ages Junior level and up. Your *Trails & Tales* adventure can take place during a weekend, over several months or last all year long. You can plan your Trails & Tales adventure with your troop or take off on your own (with your family)! When you are through you may order the appropriate patch to **correspond to the geographical section of the council for the "Trail" that you followed**, from the council shop. This patch has several components, the base patch which is the wagon (\$ 1.75 each + tax) and then each wheel has three separate pieces (\$1.00 each + tax) which represents the Western, Central and Eastern sections of the northern and southern parts of western Oklahoma. They may be ordered and worn by girls or adults. The internet, your local school library, local Chamber of Commerce and Tourism centers are great information sources for planning the places you would like to include in your *Trails & Tales* adventure.

That 's all there is to it! You may want to include an overnight at one of your council 's camps, so be sure and plan far enough in advance to make your reservations. Always be sure and contact any museums or businesses you are wanting to visit in advance. Avoid any disappointments or chances of getting lost by planning!
