



Camp Ekowah Rental Fees

For Troops and Service Units

Reservation Information

Before submitting your reservation request, please have the following information:

- Preferred arrival and departure dates, plus at least two alternative options in case your first choice is unavailable.
- Total number of anticipated attendees, including Girl Scouts, tagalongs (non-Girl Scout children), adult females and adult males. All adults must be registered and background-checked Girl Scout members.
- Required names: Troop or Service Unit Manager, secondary emergency contact, first aid-certified adult and outdoor-trained adult (these last two roles must be held by different adults, per GSUSA policy).

Helpful Information

Check-In / Check-Out:

- Check-in for overnight use begins at 4 p.m.; check-out is by 12 p.m.
- The camp gate remains closed outside of these times.
- Early check-in requests must be submitted at least two weeks in advance and are approved based on availability.

Payment Policy:

- 50% of the total balance is due within seven days of booking. The remaining balance is due at check-in.

Additional Information:

- No food preparation or storage is allowed in buildings outside of the Dining Hall, Staff House or Health Station.
- Overnight stays are only permitted in designated cabins, tree houses, Staff House, Health Station or tent areas. All other buildings are for day use only.
- Staffing and weather dependent, you will receive one of the following adventure activities at no cost: archery, canoeing, low ropes or swimming.
- Unless you rent the entire campsite, other Girl Scout groups may be present. Please be courteous.

Sleeping Accomodations

All overnight stays include use of fire pits and Starlit Fields. Overnight cabin rentals include use of the Dining Hall, Long House and the McCasland Activity Center.

Overnight tent and hammock camping require an additional fee for use of additional spaces.

Adventure Activities

The following activities require facilitation from a certified guide or instructor.

Name	Description	Price
Archery	Archery helps Girl Scouts develop focus, confidence and coordination in a safe, structured environment. The range includes compound bows, hay-bale targets, ground quivers, arm guards and finger tabs. Personal equipment is not permitted.	\$10 / Person
Low Ropes	Grandpa's Low Ropes Course encourages teamwork, trust and communication through ground-level obstacles. Activities challenge groups to problem-solve while building confidence and cooperation.	\$10 / Person
Swimming	Enjoy a refreshing swim in the Camp Ekowah pool! Lifeguard supervision is required according to American Red Cross guidelines. User groups must provide watchers at all water activities.	\$10 / Person \$100 / minimum

Waterfront Activities

All activities follow the same core safety rules: certified adult supervision, lifejackets for all participants and use of camp-provided paddles, boats and safety gear.

User groups must provide watchers in accordance with Safety Activity Checkpoints.

Waterfront activities are \$10 / person and include canoeing, kayaking and paddleboarding.

For \$10 a person, you 'll have access to all waterfront activities.

Kayaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For participants weighing 90 lbs or less • May paddle independently 	
Paddleboarding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Typically for older or stronger participants • Height / weight recommendations may apply 	
Fishing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all Girl Scout levels. A certified Basic Water Rescuer or Lifeguard with Waterfront module must supervise. • Participants 16+ require a valid Oklahoma fishing license. Equipment can be brought from home or rented from camp. 	Free
Fishing Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Includes tackle box and five fishing poles 	\$20 / group
